In Disneyland, general information may be obtained at **City Hall** on the west side of Town Square. Information about public transportation (including schedules) and other Southern California attractions is available at **Carefree Corner** on the east end of Main Street.

If you need information or assistance during your visit, feel free to ask any Disneyland Cast member. He or she will be more than glad to help you.

## Disneyland Tickets and Passports

One-, Two- and Three-Day Disneyland Passports and Child Passports (for ages 3-11) provide unlimited use of all adventures and attractions (except Arcades) and may be purchased at any Main Entrance Ticket Booth.

Major credit cards are accepted. Children two and under are admitted free. Young children should be accompanied by an adult on all attractions.

## Senior Fun Passport

A reduced-price Passport is available to those 60 and over every Sunday through Friday from September through June.

Additional discounts are available through the Magic Years Club, a Disney club offering travel and leisure benefits to seniors. For more information, call or write Disney's Magic Years Club, P.O. Box 4709, Anaheim, CA 92803, (714) 490-3250.

## Seasonal Passport

The Seasonal Passport gives the holder admission to Disneyland and use of all attractions during selected seasonal periods. Check with Disneyland Guest Relations for complete details.

## Annual Passport

The keys to the Kingdom, the Disneyland Annual Passport gives the holder unlimited admission to Disneyland during regular operating hours and use of all attractions, plus free parking, for one year.

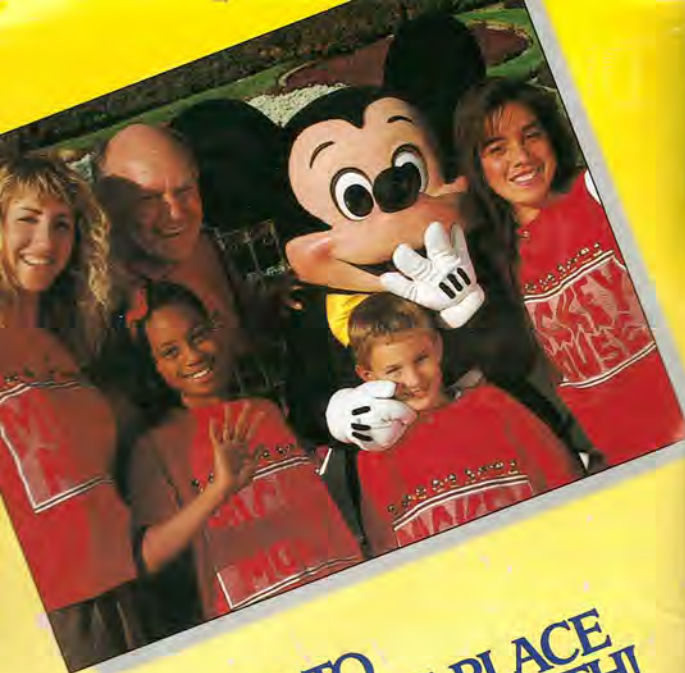

## Guided Tours

## Disney Dollars

Available in \$1, \$5 and \$10 denominations at a one-for-one exchange rate with U.S. Currency. Disney Dollars can be used for all purchases throughout Disneyland Park and the Disneyland Hotel. Disney Dollars can be purchased at all ticket booths, the Main Street Penny Arcade, Tomorrowland Starcade, City Hall and the Newsstand. They are also available at the Disneyland Hotel Monorail Station and at the front desk. Cash in on the Fun!

## American Express

American Express is the Official Credit Card of Disneyland and is accepted at the Main Entrance and in many of the shops, stores and restaurants.

## Banking Services

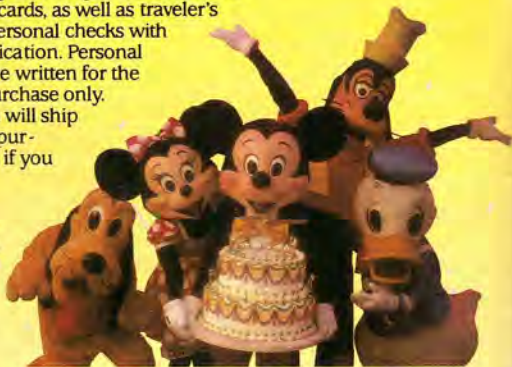
Bank of America, located on the east side of Town Square, provides complete banking services from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily. A Versateller is located west of the Disneyland Main Entrance. Checks up to \$20 can be cashed with proper identification at the Penny Arcade on Main Street and the Starcade in Tomorrowland.

Most Disneyland shops and restaurants accept credit cards, as well as traveler's checks and personal checks with proper identification. Personal checks may be written for the amount of purchase only.

Most shops will ship or mail your purchased items, if you so desire.

## First Aid

First Aid is located at the east end of Main Street next to the Plaza Inn. A registered nurse is on duty at all times.

## Special Services for Disabled Guests

Accommodations have been made throughout Disneyland for disabled guests. For specific information, obtain a copy of the Disneyland Handicap Guest Guide at Carefree Corner or Strollers and Wheelchairs.

## Wheelchair Guests

In this guide book, this wheelchair symbol  indicates areas where you may remain in your wheelchair at all times. Some attractions require that you be able to leave your wheelchair.  A member of your party may assist you in and out of these attractions.

## Strollers and Wheelchairs

Stroller and wheelchair rentals are available for a nominal charge and refundable deposit. Located on the east side of the Disneyland Main Entrance, just inside the gate.

## Kennels presented by Gaines

Pets may be boarded in the Disneyland Kennel, which is east of the Disneyland Main Entrance. Sorry, pets cannot be kept overnight.

## Lost and Found

Lost items may be claimed at Lost and Found, located on the east side of Main Street around the corner from Market House.

## Lost Children

Facilities for the care of lost children are maintained at Lost Children. Lost child inquiries are handled at City Hall.

## Baby Center presented by Gerber

Located on the east end of Main Street between Carefree Corner and First Aid, the Baby Center provides facilities for preparing formulas, warming bottles, breast-feeding and changing diapers. Disposable diapers and a limited selection of baby food are also available at the Market House on Main Street. Sorry, baby-sitting is not available.

## Storage Lockers

Lockers for storing garments, personal belongings and purchases are located adjacent to Lost and Found and Videopolis.

Lockers large enough for suitcases are located near the Parking Lot Tram stop, west of the Disneyland Main Entrance.

## Tips to make your visit more pleasant

Here are a few suggestions to save you time and energy, thus enabling you to enjoy your day at Disneyland to the fullest:

### Attractions

No matter what the season, the best time to see the most popular attractions is early in the day (before noon) and just before closing.

Also, plan on eating your meals early or late so you'll avoid the lunch and dinner rushes.

If you plan to do some shopping, don't hold off until the end of the day. The shops are usually the busiest at that time.

The descriptions on pages 10-27 will help you decide what attractions you'd like to see, where you might want to eat, and which shops you'd like to browse through. The Park map on the inside is a helpful guide.

No tickets are required on any attraction: your Passport provides unlimited use of all adventures and attractions (except arcades).

*Please Note: Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times in Disneyland. We request that no food or beverages be brought into Disneyland. A picnic area is located west of the Main Entrance for your convenience. Also, for the sake of those around you, we request that there be no flash photography, eating or drinking in any attraction. **Smoking is not permitted in any attraction or waiting area. We thank you for your cooperation and consideration.***

### Reentry to Disneyland

If you wish to leave Disneyland and return the same day during regular operating hours, a valid Disneyland passport and a hand stamp are required for re-admission. You may also reenter the parking lot on the same day (free of charge) if you retain your parking ticket and present it at the Guest Parking Entrance.

Disneyland Hotel guests and visitors leaving by way of the Disneyland Hotel Monorail Station, must have a valid Disneyland passport and a hand stamp as they exit the station if they plan to return to Disneyland the same day.

### Disney Characters

Disney characters can be found throughout Disneyland at any given time. You can usually find Mickey and his friends in Town Square (except during parade times). Just keep your eyes open and your camera ready.

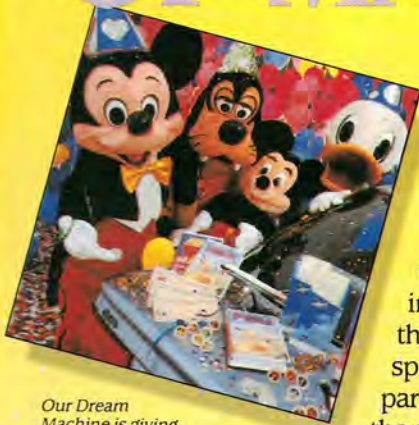
### Photo Processing by Fox Photo

Film may be dropped off at various locations throughout the park and at the Disneyland Hotel for two-hour or next-day processing by Fox Photo. You may pick up your prints at the Camera Center on Main Street or Castle Sundries at the Disneyland Hotel.

*Attention Young at Heart! Splash Mountain, Space Mountain, Star Tours, Matterhorn Bobsleds, Big Thunder Mountain Railroad and Autopia have boarding restrictions. Guests should be in good health and free from heart, back or neck problems, motion sickness or other conditions that could be aggravated by these adventures. Expectant mothers and children under 3 should not ride. See a host or hostess at these attractions for more information.*

# KODAK PICTURE TIPS FOR Disneyland.

**1** For sharp pictures, hold your camera steady as you gently press the shutter release.

**2** Add a feeling of depth to your pictures by "framing" the subject with a foreground object such as an arch or tree branch.



**3** Personalize your pictures by including friends or family members in the foreground.

**4** For natural pictures of people have them involved in a fun activity rather than staring at the camera.



**5** Make title pictures for your picture story by photographing identifying signs.

**6** Concentrate attention on your main subject by moving in close enough for it to fill the entire viewfinder (check your camera manual for the minimum subject distance).



**7** You may want to capture interesting details of subjects by moving in close. With the close-up setting on some Kodak cameras you can get as close as 18 inches.

**8** For good flash pictures be sure to keep your subject within the flash distance range for your camera. Flashes are not functional for subjects beyond 50 feet, such as fireworks.

**9** If you have a 35mm camera, you can photograph outdoor subjects after sundown and indoor subjects using fast films, such as KODACOLOR GOLD 400 Films (set exposure meter at 400) and KODACOLOR VR 1000 Films (set exposure meter at 1000).
