A Suggested Itinerary For Your Tour —

NOTE: The itinerary described below is only an introduction to Disneyland. It has been designed to assist those on the half-day tour to see the most in the time available. Those who have the full four hours to spend at the Park may follow the same route, then retrace their steps to try other attractions or visit a few of the outstanding exhibits sponsored by some of America's major industries.

During the two hours of your visit today you will be able to see all of Disneyland's five major areas and sample some of the unique adventures in each. The map of Disneyland in this folder illustrates the Park's convenient "five land" layout. We suggest you "chart a course" and refer to the map as you make your tour.

While personal preference should guide the choice of which Disneyland adventures you wish to sample, our guests have established certain attractions as favorites. These are listed here for your information...

For your introduction to the Magic Kingdom we suggest a trip aboard one of the Santa Fe & Disneyland trains which leaves every few minutes from the Main Street Depot, located just inside the Main Entrance. This ride provides the finest overall view of the Park available, as it travels the "great circle" route completely around Disneyland.

Then stroll or be driven up Main Street USA, "Heartline of America," to the Park's Central Plaza. From this point — the geographic center of Disneyland — the entrances to the four lands are only steps away in each direction.

In **ADVENTURELAND** we recommend the Rivers of the World Jungle Boat Cruise, an exciting safari through untamed jungles which has been enjoyed by more than 8 million visitors.

In **FRONTIERLAND** we suggest a cruise on the Rivers of America — aboard either the paddle-wheeling MARK TWAIN or the three-masted schooner COLUMBIA of 1790 vintage. You may also be one of the first to enjoy Disneyland's newest attraction, a trip through Nature's Wonderland, opened in June of 1960.

In **FANTASYLAND** the Storybook Land Canal boats have been a consistent favorite with young and old... or you may like flying high over moonlit London to Never-Never Land with Peter Pan.

In **TOMORROWLAND** you'll enjoy a voyage through liquid space aboard Nautilus-patterned submarines or get a first-hand preview of tomorrow's rapid transit aboard America's first operating monorail system, the Disneyland-Alweg Monorail.

In the time remaining, a visit to the shops located in each of the lands is sure to please — or you may enjoy refreshments at one of the 20 restaurants and food service facilities at Disneyland.

INFORMATION

You may obtain general information about Disneyland at City Hall on Main Street or from any Disneyland Security Officer. Information about public transportation schedules and other Southern California points of interest available at North America Companies Carefree Corner on Main Street.

FIRST AID

Registered nurses are on duty in the First Aid center, adjacent to the Lost Children's facility, end of East Plaza Street.

PUBLIC TELEPHONES

Located in each of the lands. Ask a Disneyland employee for the location of the one nearby.

BANKING SERVICE

Bank of America provides service at its Town Square location every day Disneyland is open, including Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

REST ROOMS

Located in each of the lands. Any employee will direct you to the nearest one.

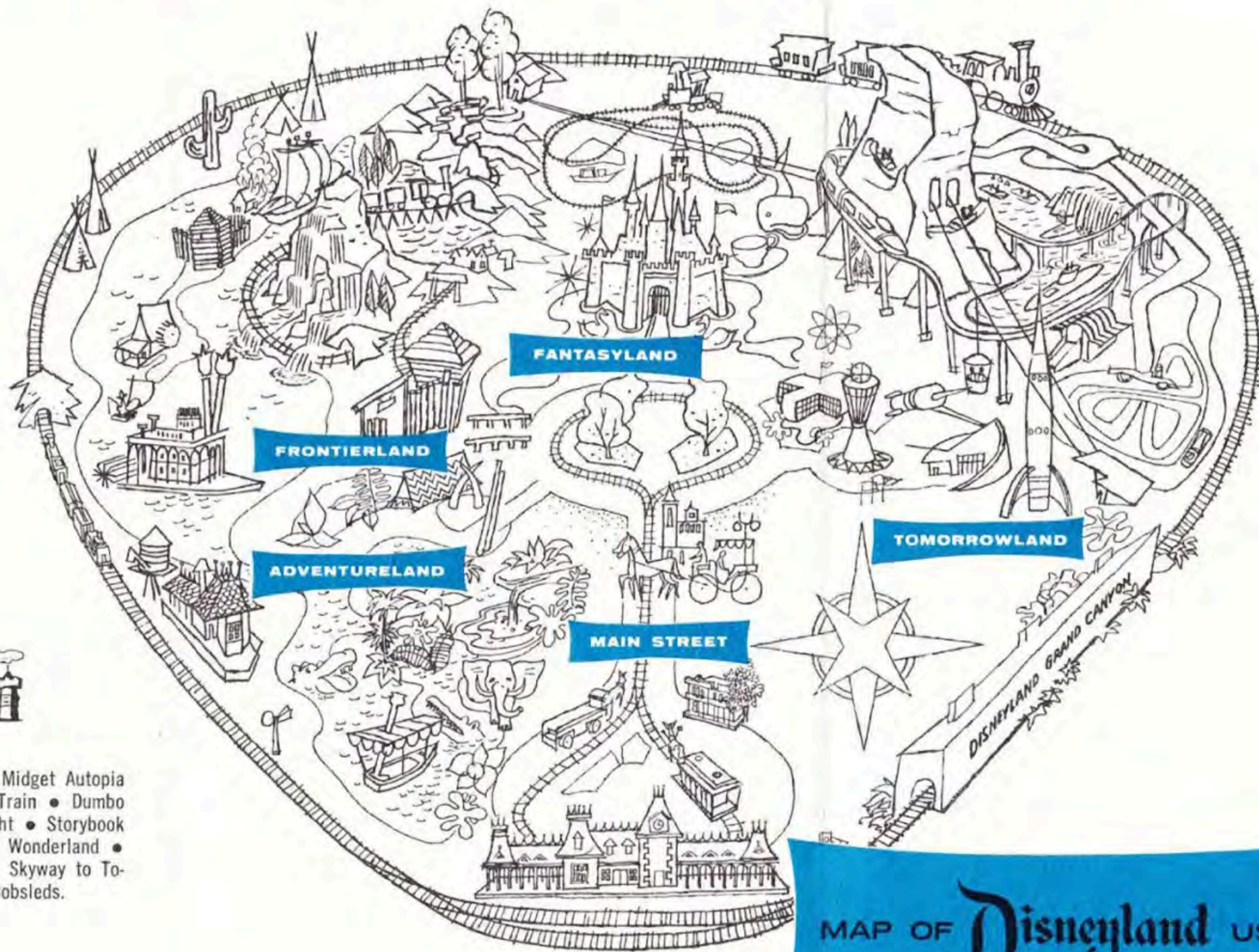
