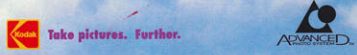

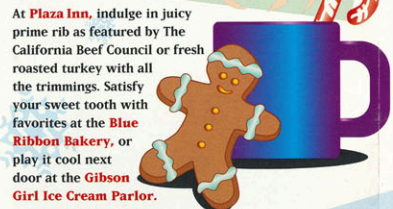

Guest Services and Information

TIPS to Make Your Visit More Pleasant

Guided Tours. If it's your first time to Disneyland, or if you are ready to look at the Park in a whole new way, considering taking a Guided Tour! The "Welcome to Disneyland" tour is designed to give you a guided tour or a basic introduction to Disneyland and some of its most famous features. The two-hour "A Walk in Walt's Footsteps" tour offers a more detailed historical look at Disneyland through the eyes of its founder, Walt Disney. Guided Tours depart every morning, and tickets are available at City Hall and the Main Entrance. Length of tour may vary depending on wait time for attractions. All tours are subject to availability.

Package Express. Package Express provides the opportunity for Guests to shop throughout the Park and have their purchases sent to the Main Entrance Newsstand for pick-up later in the day. Disneyland Hotel and Disneyland Pacific Hotel Guests may request that their purchases be delivered to Bell Services for next-day pick-up. Please ask any store Cast Member for details. Please allow at least two hours between purchase and pick-up.

Safety Considerations. For your safety while on attractions, please keep your hands, arms and legs inside the vehicle at all times. Young children should be accompanied by an adult.

At parade time, please honor designated viewing areas and crosswalks. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times in Disneyland. We request that no food or beverages be brought into Disneyland. A picnic area is located west of the Main Entrance for your convenience. Also, for the comfort of those around you, we request that there be no flash photography, eating or drinking in any attractions.

For your safety, the following requirements apply:

- 1-year minimum age:** Autopia
- 3-year minimum age:** Goody's Go Coaster, Matterhorn Bobsleds, 400-inch (102 cm) maximum height AND 3-year minimum age: Big Thunder Mountain, Space Mountain, Splash Mountain, Star Tours, 48-inch (117 cm) minimum height: Indiana Jones Adventure, 52-inch (132 cm) maximum height AND 3-year minimum age: Goody's Boogie House, 52-inch (132 cm) minimum height AND 7-year minimum age: Autopia (to drive alone).

For your convenience, you may visit the Central Plaza Information Center where Guests can be measured prior to entering an attraction queue. Parents with young children may take turns experiencing the above attractions. Please contact a Cast Member at the location for additional information.

Smoking. For the comfort of all our Guests, smoking is prohibited in all waiting areas, attractions, shows, dining areas, restrooms and locations designed for parades and stage show viewing.



Please look for the recycling containers throughout the Resort, and join us in our commitment to the environment.

Complete Disneyland, Resort information is available at Disneyland Information Centers (P on the map) located at City Hall, Central Plaza and the Main Entrance. The Central Plaza Information Center posts wait times for many Park attractions as well as show and parade times for the day. Also feel free to ask any Cast Member for assistance; he/she will be happy to answer your questions.

American Express. American Express is the Official Card of Disneyland and is accepted at the Main Entrance and in many of the stores and restaurants. A 24-hour ATM is available in the Travelport of the Disneyland Hotel. Most ATMs (E on the map) in Disneyland also accept the American Express Card.

Baby Care Center, hosted by Carnation Baby Formulas. Located on the northeast end of Main Street between the Camera Shop and First Aid, the Baby Care Center provides facilities for preparing formulas, warming bottles, nursing and changing diapers. The Center also offers numerous baby sundries: for purchase including diapers, Carnation formulas, bottles and pacifiers. Diaper machines and changing tables are located in most men's and women's restrooms throughout the Park. Diapers are also available for purchase at smaller rental locations (P on the map).

Check Cashing. Personal checks may be written for the amount of purchase. With proper identification, you may cash checks for a limited amount of the Bank of Main Street and the Starcade in Tomorrowland.

Credit Cards. American Express, the Disney Credit Card, VISA, MasterCard, Discover and JCB are accepted at the Main Entrance and in many stores and restaurants.

Disney Dollars. Use throughout the Disneyland Resort. Disney Dollars are available in \$1, \$5, and \$10 denominations at a one-for-one exchange rate with U.S. currency. Disney Dollars may be purchased at all ticket booths. City Hall, the Bank of Main Street, some Park merchandise locations and the front desk of the Disneyland Hotel and the Disneyland Pacific Hotel. Cash in on the fun!

Disneyland Passports. Each Passport provides unlimited use of all attractions (except Arcades). Young children should be accompanied by an adult.

To leave Disneyland and return the same day during regular operating hours, either via the Main Entrance or the Main Street Station of the Disneyland Hotel, a valid Disneyland Passport and hand stamp are required for re-entry. You may also request the Parking Lot on the same day (free of charge) if you retain your parking receipt and present it at the Guest Parking Entrance.

Foreign Currency. Foreign currency may be presented for most purchases at the Disneyland Resort for the current exchange rate. It may also be exchanged for U.S. currency or Disney Dollars at City Hall, the Bank of Main Street and the Starcade in Tomorrowland.

kennel Club, hosted by Friskies. Board your pets for a nominal charge in the Disneyland Kennel, just east of the Disneyland Main Entrance. Sorry, no facilities for overnight accommodations.

Lost and Found. Inquire about your lost items here. Located on the east side of Main Street, U.S.A. (E on the map) around the corner from the Market House.

Lost Guests. Guests under the age of 12 are escorted to Lost Children, located next to First Aid. Guests 12 years of age and over may leave a written message at City Hall.

Parking Lot Assistance. The Automobile Club of Southern California (ACSC) and AAA are proud to offer the following free services to all Disneyland Resort guests: stalled car services, flat tire changing, and towing up to three miles (pump starts and lock-out services are provided by Disneyland). Contact a Disneyland Cast Member to assist you with the above services.

Services for Guests with Disabilities. For specific information, please refer to the Guidebook for Guest with Disabilities available at Park Information Centers (P on the map) and wheelchair rental location. An audio tape tour of Disneyland, Disneyland Park Braille Guidebook and written aids for many Disneyland attractions are available for use while visiting the Park. Assistive Listening, reflective captioning and closed captioning (in Fresh Air areas only) are offered at several attractions throughout the Park. Please refer to legend and attraction lists for exact locations.

A limited number of wheelchairs and Electric Convenience Vehicles are available to rent just inside the Main Entrance (E on the map). Guests must be at least 18 years of age to rent or operate an Electric Convenience Vehicle.

*Please visit City Hall for assistance. Refundable deposit required. **Rental fee and refundable deposit required.

Stroller Rentals hosted by Carnation Baby Formulas. A limited number of stroller rentals are available for a nominal charge on a first-come, first-served basis. Rental vouchers may be purchased at any Main Entrance ticket booth, or at central locations found just inside the Main Entrance and at the Star Trader in Tomorrowland (S on the map). Strollers cannot be accommodated on attractions, including the Disneyland Railroad and Disneyland Monorail.
