GUEST SERVICES

General information on the Disneyland Resort may be obtained at Disneyland Information Centers (shown on the map with a **E**) located at City Hall (west side of Town Square), the Central Plaza Information Desk (near the entrance to Adventureland) or the Guest Information Booth (Main Entrance). The Information Centers can also answer questions about Southern California attractions and public transportation. These locations also offer specific operating hours for most Resort locations which may operate seasonally or on a limited basis. The Central Plaza Information Desk posts wait times for favorite Disneyland attractions as well as daily parade and show schedules.

American Express. American Express is the Official Credit Card of Disneyland and is accepted at the Main Entrance and in many of the stores and restaurants. A 24-hour ATM is available in the Travelport of the Disneyland Hotel. Most ATMs (**E**) on the map in Disneyland also accept the American Express Card.

Baby Care Center, hosted by Carnation Infant Formula. Located on the northeast end of Main Street between the Camera Shop and First Aid, the Baby Care Center provides facilities for preparing formulas, warming bottles, nursing and changing diapers. The Center also offers numerous baby sundries for purchase including Carnation formulas, bottles and pacifiers. Diaper machines and changing tables (**E**) on the map) are located in men's and women's rest rooms throughout the Park.

Check Cashing. Personal checks may be written for the amount of purchase. With proper identification, you may cash checks for a limited amount at the Bank of Main Street and the Starcade in Tomorrowland.

Credit Cards. American Express, The Disney Credit Card, VISA, MasterCard, Discover and JCB are accepted at the Main Entrance and in many stores and restaurants.

Disney Dollars. Use throughout the Disneyland Resort. Disney Dollars are available in \$1, \$5, and \$10 denominations at a one-for-one exchange rate with U.S. currency. Disney Dollars may be purchased at all ticket booths, City Hall, the Bank of Main Street, some Park merchandise locations and the front desk of the Disneyland Hotel and the Disneyland Pacific Hotel. Cash in on the fun!

Disneyland Passports. Each Passport provides unlimited use of all attractions (except Arcades). Young children should be accompanied by an adult.

If you wish to leave Disneyland and return the same day during regular operating hours, either via the Main Entrance or the Monorail Station at the Disneyland Hotel, a valid Disneyland Passport and a hand stamp are required for readmission. You may also reenter the Parking Lot on the same day (free of charge) if you retain your parking receipt and present it at the Guest Parking Entrance.

Foreign Currency. Foreign currency may be presented for most purchases at the Disneyland Resort for the current exchange rate or exchanged for cash at Disney Dollars at the Bank of Main Street and the Starcade in Tomorrowland.

Kennel Club, hosted by Friskies. Board your pets for a nominal charge in the Disneyland Kennel, just east of the Disneyland Main Entrance. Sorry, no facilities for overnight accommodations.

Lost and Found. Inquire about your lost items here. Located on the east side of Main Street, U.S.A., (**E**) on the map) around the corner from the Market House.

Lost Guests. Guests under the age of 12 are escorted to Lost Children, located next to First Aid, Main Street, U.S.A. Guests 12 years of age and over may leave a written message at City Hall in Town Square.

Special Services for Guests with Disabilities. Accommodations have been made throughout Disneyland for Guests with disabilities. For specific information, obtain your copy of the Guidebook for Guests with Disabilities. An audio tape tour "of Disneyland and Disneyland Park Braille Guidebook" are available in City Hall for Guests with visual impairments. Written aids are available for use at many Disneyland attractions. Please visit City Hall for a complete listing. A limited number of wheelchairs** and Electric Convenience Vehicles** are available. Guests must be at least 18 years of age to rent or operate an Electric Convenience Vehicle. (**E**) on the map)

Stroller Rentals hosted by Carnation Infant Formula. A limited number of stroller rentals are available for a nominal charge on a first-come, first-served basis. They are located on the east side of the Disneyland Main Entrance, just inside the gate, and at the Star Trader in Tomorrowland (**E**) on the map), or a rental voucher may be purchased at any Disneyland Ticket Booth. Strollers cannot be accommodated on attractions, including the Disneyland Railroad and Disneyland Monorail.
