

Guided Tours If it's your first time to Disneyland or if you are ready to look at the Park in a whole new way, consider taking a Guided Tour! The "Welcome To Disneyland" tour is designed to give the first-time visitor a basic introduction to Disneyland and some of its most famous features For a little more historical detail, try "A Walk In Walt's Footsteps." This two-hour tour takes a historical look at Disneyland through the eyes of its founder, Walt Disney, Guided Tours depart every morning, and tickets are available at City Hall and the Main Entrance, Note: Length of tour may vary depending on wait time for attractions. Package Express. For your shopping convenience. Safety Considerations, For your safety while on attractions, please keep your arms and leas inside the vehicle at all times. Young children should be accompanied by an adult.

Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times in Disneyland. We request that no food or beverages be brought into Disneyland. A picnic area is located west of the Main Entrance for your convenience. Also, for the comfort of those ground you, we request that there be no flast photography, eating or drinking in any attractions.

For your safety, the following requirements apply:

1-year minimum age: Autopia, Rocket Jets.

3-year minimum age: Gadget's Go Coaster, Matterhorn Bobsleds.

40-inch (102 cm) minimum height AND 3-year minimum age: Big Thunder Mountain, Space Mountain Splack Mountain Star Tours

46-inch (117 cm) minimum height: Indiana Jones TM Adventure.

48-inch (122 cm) maximum height AND 3-year minimum age: Chip 'n Dale Acorn Crawl. 52-inch (132 cm) maximum height AND 3-year minimum age: Goofy's Bounce House. 52-inch (132 cm) minimum height AND 7-year minimum age: Autopia (to drive alone).


At parade time we ask that you please honor designated parade viewing areas and use designated crosswalks.
