TIPS to Make Your Visit More Pleasant

Guided Tours. If it's your first time to Disneyland, or if you are ready to look at the Park in a whole new way, consider taking a Guided Tour! The "Welcome to Disneyland™" tour is designed to give the first-time visitor a basic introduction to Disneyland and some of its most famous features. The two-hour "A Walk in Walk's Footsteps" tour offers a more detailed historical look at Disneyland through the eyes of its founder, Walt Disney. Guided Tours depart every morning, and tickets are available at City Hall and the Main Entrance. *Length of tour may vary depending on wait time for attractions. All tours are subject to availability.

Package Express. Package Express provides the opportunity for Guests to shop throughout the Park and have their purchases sent to the Main Entrance Newsstand for pick-up later in the day. Disneyland Hotel and Disneyland Pacific Hotel Guests may request that their purchases be delivered to Ball Services for next day pick-up. Please ask any store Cast Member for details. Please allow at least two hours between purchase and pick-up.

Safety Considerations. We work hard to offer a comfortable, safe and enjoyable experience for all of our guests. Please assist us by showing common courtesy to fellow park guests. Please be respectful of others. Do not use profanity or engage in unsafe, illegal or offensive behavior. Please abide by all safety warnings and notices. Proper attire—including shoes and shirts—must be worn at all times in Disneyland.

For your safety while on attractions, please keep your hands, arms and legs inside the vehicle at all times. Young children should be accompanied by an adult.

At parade time, please honor designated viewing areas and crosswalks.

We request that no food or beverages be brought into Disneyland. A picnic area is located west of the Main Entrance for your convenience. Also, for the comfort of those around you, we request that there be no flash photography, eating or drinking in any attractions.

52-inch (132 cm) maximum height AND 3-year minimum age: Goofy's Bounce House.

52-inch (132 cm) minimum height AND 7-year minimum age: Autopia (No drivers only).

For your convenience, you may visit the Central Plaza Information Center where guests can be measured prior to entering an attraction queue.

Guests with young children may take turns experiencing the above attractions. Please contact a Cast Member at the location for additional information.

Services for Guests with Disabilities. For specific information, please refer to the Guidebook for Guests with Disabilities available at Park Information Centers (i) on the map) and wheelchair rental location. An audio tape tour of Disneyland, Disneyland Park Braille Guidebook and written aids for many Disneyland attractions are available for use while visiting the Park. Assistive listening, reflective captioning and closed captioning (in Preshow areas only) are offered at several attractions throughout the Park. Please refer to legend and attraction listings for exact locations.

A limited number of wheelchairs** and Electric Convenience Vehicles*** are available to rent just inside the Main Entrance (E on the map). Guests must be at least 18 years of age to rent or operate an Electric Convenience Vehicle.
