

The two-hour "A Walk In Walt's Footstens" tour offers a more detailed historical look at Disneyland through the eyes of its founder Walt Disney Guided Tours depart every morning, and tickets are available at City Hall and the Main Entrance "Length of tour may vary depending on wait time for attractions. All tours are subject to availability

Package Express Porkage Express provides the apportunity for Guests to shop throughout the Park and have their purchases sent to the Main Entrance Newsstand for pick-up later in the day, Disneyland Hotel and Disneyland Parific Hotel Guests may request that their purchases be delive ered to Bell Services for next day pick-up. Please ask any store Cast Member for details. Please allow at least two hours between purchase and pick-up.

Safety Considerations. We work hard to offer a comfortable safe and enjoyable experience for all of our quests. Please assist us by showing common courtesy to fellow park guests. Please be respectful of others. Do not use profanity or engage in unsafe, illegal or offensive behavior. Please abide by all safety warnings and notices. Proper attire—including shoes and shirts—must be worn at all times in Disneyland

The Central Plaza Information Center posts wait times for many Park attractions as well as show and parade times for the day. Also feel free to ask any Cast Member for assistance; he/she will be happy to answer your

American Express, American Express is the Official Cord of Disneyland and is accepted at the Main Entrance and in many of the stores and restaurants. A 24-hour ATM is available in the Travelport of the Disneyland Hotel, Most ATMs () on the map) in Disneyland also accept the American Express Card.

Baby Care Center, hosted by Carnation Baby Formulas, located on the northeast end of Main Street between the Camera Shop and First Aid, the Baby Care Center provides facilities for preparing formulas, warming bottles, nursing and changing digners. The Center also offers numerous baby sundries for purchase including diagers. Carnation formulas, battles and pacifiers. Diaper machines and changing tables are located in most men's and women's rest rooms throughout the Park. Diapers are also available for purchase at stroller rental locations (Talon the map).

Check Cashing, Personal checks may be written for the amount of purchase. With proper identification, you may cash checks for a limited amount at the Bank of Main Street and the

Credit Cards, American Express, The Disney Credit Card, VISA, MasterCard, Discover and JCB are accepted at the Main Entrance and in many stores and restaurants.

Disney Dollars. Use throughout the Disneyland Resort, Disney Dollars are available in S1 S5. and S10 denominations at a one-for-one exchange rate with U.S. currency. Disney Dollars may be purchased at all ticket booths. City Hall, the Bank of Main Street, some Park merchandiss locations and the front desk of the Dispeyland Hotel and the Dispeyland Pacific Hotel. Cash in on

Disneyland Passports. Each Passport provides unlimited use of all attractions (except Arrades). Young children should be accompanied by an adult:

To leave Disneyland and return the same day during regular operating hours, either via the Main Entrance or the Managail Station at the Disneyland Hotel, a valid Disneyland Passport and hand storm are required for readmission. You may also reenter the Parking Lot on the same day (free of charge) if you retain your parking receipt and present it at the Guest Parking Entrance.

Foreign Currency, Foreign currency may be presented for most nurchoses at the Disneyland Resort for the current exchange rate. It may also be exchanged for U.S. currency

or Disney Dollars at City Hall, the Bank of Main Street and the Starcade in Tomorrowland Kennel Club, hosted by Friskies. Board your pets for a nominal charge in the
