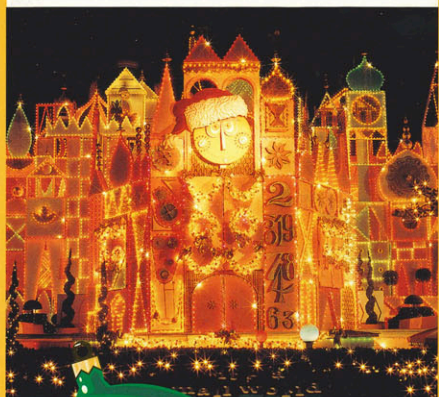

At Your Service

Complete Disneyland Resort information, including operating hours for Park attractions, restaurants and stores is available at Disneyland Information Centers (I) on the map). The Central Plaza Information Center posts wait times for many Park attractions as well as show and parade times for the day.

American Express. American Express is the Official Card of Disneyland and is accepted at the Main Entrance and in many of the stores and restaurants. A 24-hour ATM is available in the Townport of the Disneyland Hotel. Most ATMs (I) on the map) in Disneyland also accept the American Express Card.

AT&T Prepaid Cards. Vending machines offering 510 and 520 AT&T Prepaid Cards are located inside Star Line and located on Main Street, U.S.A., at the Starliner in Tomorrowland, and at Mickey's Corner at the Disneyland Hotel.

Baby Care Center, hosted by Cast Member Baby Formulas. Located on the northeast end of Main Street (I) on the map), the facility provides for preparing formulas, warming bottles, nursing and changing diapers. The Center also offers numerous baby supplies for purchase. Diaper machines and changing tables are located in most men's and women's rest rooms throughout the Park. Diapers are also available for purchase at stroller rental locations (S) on the map).

Foreign Currency. Foreign currency may be presented for most purchases at the Disneyland Resort for the current exchange rate or be exchanged for U.S. currency at City Hall, the Bank of Main Street and the Starcade in Tomorrowland.

Guided Tours. "Welcome to Disneyland" offers a basic introduction to the Park and its most famous features. The two-hour "A Walk in Walt's Footsteps" tour offers a detailed historical look at Disneyland through the eyes of its founder, Walt Disney. Tours depart every morning. Tickets are sold at City Hall and the Main Entrance. *Length of tour may vary depending on wait time for attractions. All tours are subject to availability.

Kennel Club, hosted by Freddie. Board your pets for a nominal charge at the Disneyland Kennel, just east of the Disneyland Main Entrance. Sorry, no facilities for overnight accommodations.

Lost and Found. Inquire about your lost items here (I) on the map).

Lost Guests. Guests under the age of 12 are escorted to Lost Children, located next to First Aid. Guests 12 years of age and over may leave a written message at City Hall.

Package Express. Ship through the Park and have your purchases sent to the Main Entrance Newsstand for pick-up later in the day. Please allow at least two hours between purchase and pick-up. Disneyland Hotel and Disneyland Pacific Hotel Guests may also request that purchases be delivered to Bell Services for next day pick-up. Please ask any store Cast Member for details.

AAA Parking Lot Assistance. All Disneyland Resort Guests may receive stalled car services, flat tire changing, and towing up to three miles, courtesy of AAA. (Jump starts and lock-out services are provided by Disneyland.) Contact a Disneyland Cast Member to assist you with the above services.

Safety Considerations. We work hard to offer a comfortable, safe and enjoyable experience for all of our Guests. Please assist us by showing common courtesy to fellow Park Guests. Please be respectful of others. Do not use profanity or engage in unsafe, illegal or offensive behavior. Please abide by all safety warnings and notices. Proper attire—including shoes and shirts—must be worn at all times in Disneyland. For your safety while on attractions, please keep your hands, arms and legs inside the vehicle at all times. Young children should be accompanied by an adult.

At parade time, please honor designated viewing areas and crosswalks.

We request that no food or beverages be brought into Disneyland. A picnic area is located west of the Main Entrance for your convenience. Also, for the comfort of those around you, we request that there be no flash photography, eating or drinking in any attractions.

Guests with young children may take turns experiencing attractions. Please contact a Cast Member at the location for additional information.

Services for Guests with Disabilities. For complete information, please refer to the "Guidebook for Guests with Disabilities" available at Park Information Centers (I) on the map). An audio tour "tour" of Disneyland, Disneyland Park, Buena Vista Guidebook™ and written aid for many Disneyland attractions are available for use while visiting the Park.

A limited number of wheelchairs** and Electric Convenience Vehicles** are available to rent just inside the Main Entrance (I) on the map). Guests must be at least 18 years of age to rent or operate an Electric Convenience Vehicle.

Please visit City Hall for assistance. Refundable deposit required. *Rental fee and refundable deposit required.

Smoking. For the comfort of all our Guests, smoking is prohibited in all waiting areas, attractions, stores, dining areas, rest rooms and locations designed for parades and show staging viewing.

Stroller Rentals, hosted by Cast Member Baby Formulas. A limited number of stroller rentals are available for a nominal charge on a first-come, first-served basis. Rental vouchers may be purchased at any Main Entrance ticket booth, or at rental locations found just inside the Main Entrance and at the Star Inland in Tomorrowland (I) on the map). Strollers cannot be accommodated at attractions, including the Disneyland Railroad and Disneyland Monorail.

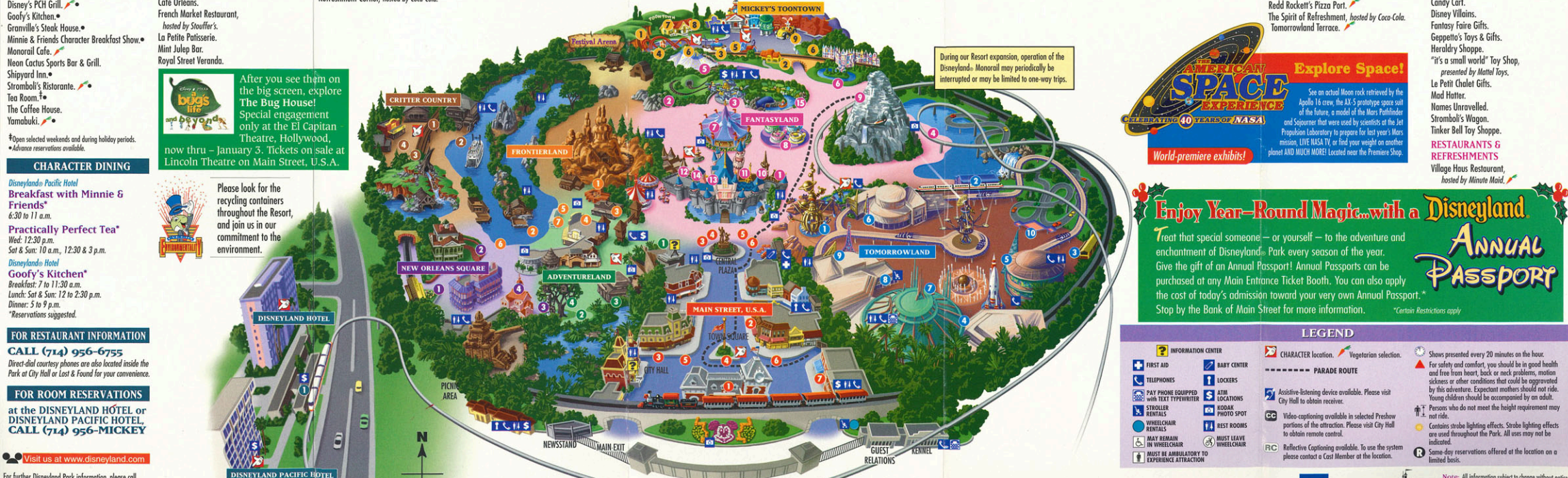
