# AT YOUR SERVICE

Complete Disneyland Resort information, including operating hours for Park attractions, restaurants and stores is available at Disneyland Information Centers (i) on the map). The Central Plaza Information Center posts wait times for many Park attractions as well as show and parade times for the day. For further Disneyland Park information, please call (714) 781-4655. For TTY Assistance, call (714) 781-4567.

**American Express** is the Official Card of Disneyland Park and is accepted at the Main Entrance and in many shops and restaurants. ATMs (A) on the map) throughout the Disneyland Resort also accept the American Express Card.

**AT&T Prepaid Cards.** Vending machines offering \$10 and \$20 AT&T Prepaid Cards are located inside Lost and Found on Main Street, U.S.A., at the Starcade in Tomorrowland and at the Disneyland Hotel.

**Baby Care Center,** hosted by Nestlé Carnation Baby Formula. Located on the northeast end of Main Street, U.S.A. (B) on the map). Provides facilities for preparing formulas, warming bottles, nursing and changing diapers. The Center also offers numerous baby supplies for purchase. Diaper machines and changing tables are located in most men's and women's rest rooms throughout the Park. Diapers are also available for purchase at stroller rental locations (S) on the map).

**Disney's FASTPASS.** Disney's FASTPASS is a FREE service that minimizes your wait at attractions marked with this symbol.

**Foreign Currency** may be presented for most purchases at the Disneyland Resort for the current exchange rate or be exchanged for U.S. currency at City Hall and the Bank of Main Street.

**Guided Tours.** "Welcome to Disneyland!" offers a basic introduction to the Park and its most famous features. The two-hour "A Walk in Walt's Footsteps" tour offers a detailed historical look at Disneyland through the eyes of its founder, Walt Disney. Tours depart every morning, tickets are sold at City Hall and the Main Entrance.

\*Length of tour may vary depending on wait time for attractions. All tours are subject to availability.

**Kennel Club,** hosted by Friskies. East of the Disneyland Main Entrance. No overnight facilities.

**Lost and Found.** Inquire about your lost items here (Main Street, U.S.A. (L) on the map).

**Lost Guests.** Guests under the age of 12 are escorted to Lost Children, located next to First Aid. Guests 12 years of age and over may leave a written message at City Hall.

**Package Express.** Shop throughout the Park and have your purchases sent to the Main Entrance Newsstand for pick-up later in the day. Please allow at least two hours between purchase and pick-up. Disneyland Hotel and Disneyland Pacific Hotel Guests may also request that purchases be delivered to Bell Services for next day pick-up. Please ask your store Cast Member for details.

**Safety Considerations.** We work hard to offer a comfortable, safe and enjoyable experience for all of our Guests. Please assist us by showing common courtesy to fellow Park Guests. Please be respectful of others. Do not use profanity or engage in unsafe, illegal or offensive behavior. Please abide by all safety warnings and notices. Proper attire - including shoes and shirts - must be worn at all times in Disneyland Park.

For your safety while on attractions, please keep your hands, arms and legs inside the vehicle at all times. Young children should be accompanied by an adult.

At parade time, please honor designated viewing areas and crosswalks.

We request that no food or beverages be brought into Disneyland Park. Also, for the comfort of those around you, we request that there be no flash photography, eating or drinking in any attractions.

**Services for Guests with Disabilities.** For complete information, please refer to the "Guidebook for Guests with Disabilities" available at Park Information Centers (i) on the map). An audio tape tour\*\* of Disneyland, Disneyland Park Braille Guidebook\*\* and written aid for many Disneyland Park attractions are available for use while visiting the Park.

A limited number of wheelchairs\*\*\* and Electric Convenience Vehicles\*\*\* are available to rent (E) on the map). Guests must be at least 18 years of age to rent or operate an Electric Convenience Vehicle.

**Smoking.** For the comfort of all our Guests, smoking is restricted to designated areas only (S) on the map.) Please refer to Park signage for designated smoking locations or ask a Cast Member for assistance.
