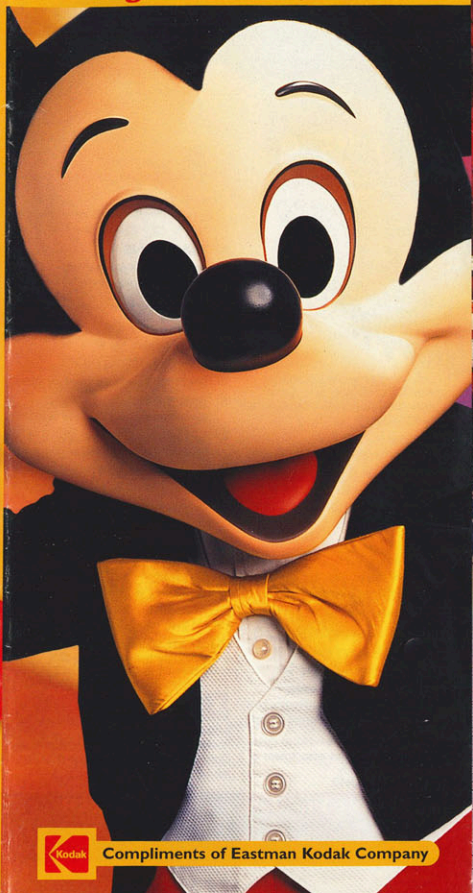

Services for Guests with Disabilities. A limited number of wheelchairs and Electric Convenience Vehicles is available to rent. Rental fee and refundable deposit required. Guests must be at least 18 years of age to rent or operate an Electric Convenience Vehicle. An audio tape tour, Braille guidebook, and written aids for several attractions are available. Please visit City Hall in Disneyland park or the Guest Relations Lobby in Disney's California Adventure™ park for assistance.
